you can make.**

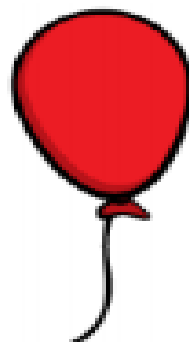
Lila says,

What is the difference between their numbers?

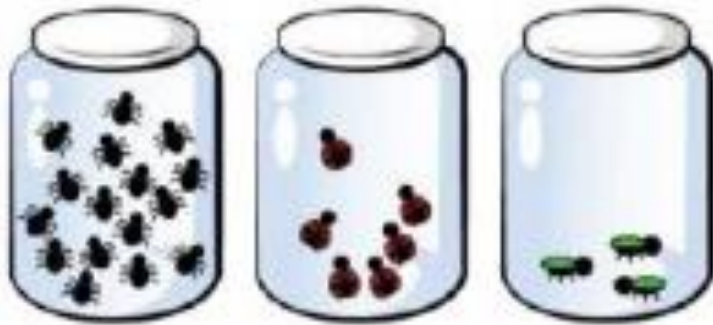
Challenge 2
