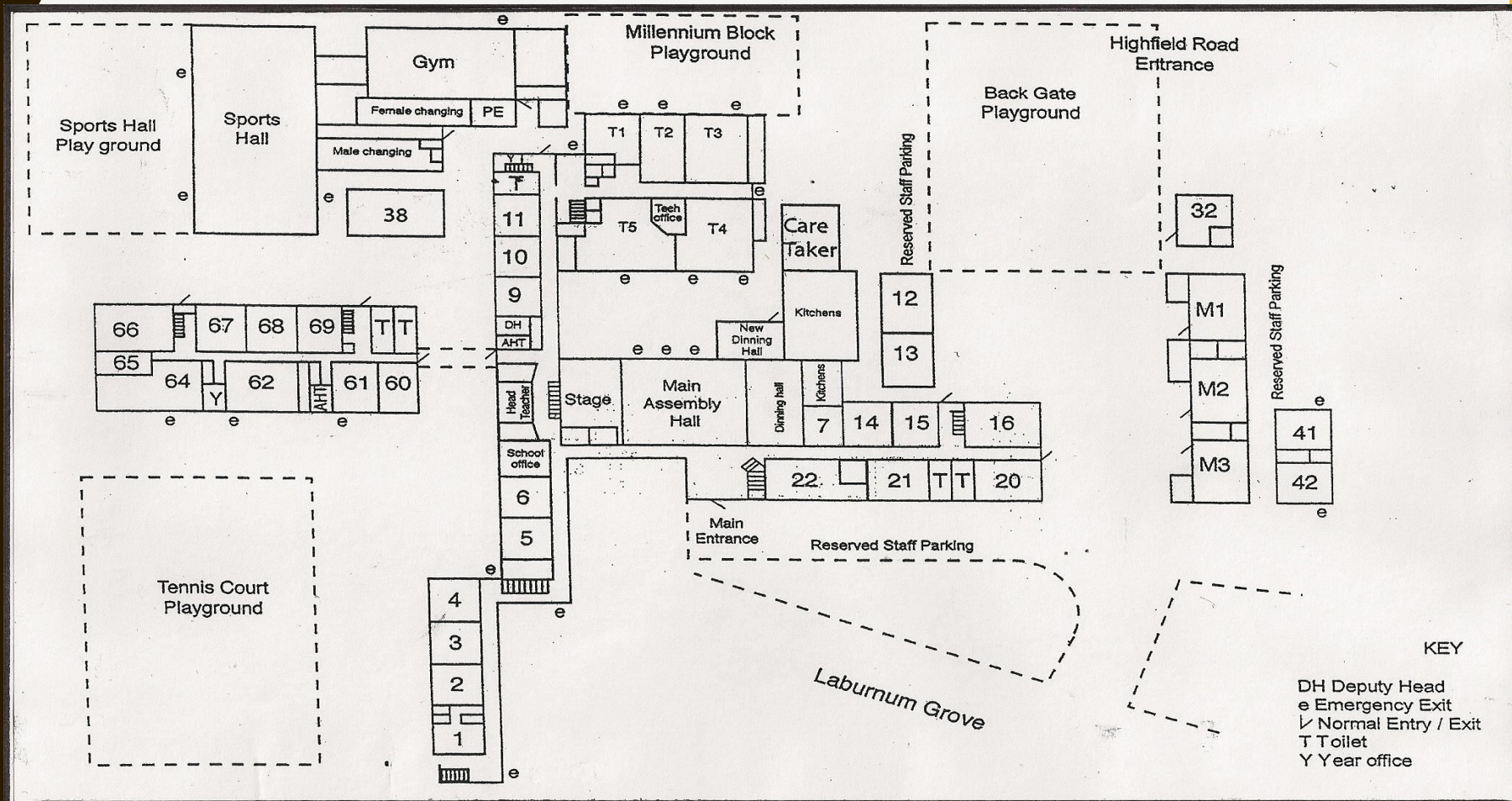
FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND YOUR
