Using your plan, draw the lines for your flower on your main scene and cut along it <b>making sure that you do not cut the edges of your scene.</b> If you make a hole at the start and end points of the arch (use a hole punch if you can) then it is easier to get the scissors in to cut along the pathway.</p> <p>3. Draw a flower on a separate piece of paper, colour it and stick it on a lollipop stick (or piece of card). You will need a long stem and leaves. As it will grow taller as it moves up your cut. Look back at the videos from Monday to have another look if you need to.</p> |
