UNDERSTANDING TIMETABLES

TIMETABLES

- They will differ from school to school. Some schools run a two-weekly timetable. That means your timetable will be different on week A and week B.
- Your day will generally start with registration and end with tutor time.
- The rest of the day will be divided into 5 or 6 periods.
- Some subjects might take place in specific blocks eg. maths, PE.
