Late collections

Please remember to collect your child/ren on time.

End of day times:

Nursery am: 11.30am Nursery pm: 3.15pm

Years 1 – 6: 3.20pm

If you are late to collect your child (ren) at the end of the school day you will receive a reminder letter. If you collect your child late again within a six week period then you will receive a second letter, with a fine. If it occurs again within a six week period then a meeting will be set up with school, yourselves and the Police Local School's section to discuss the situation. Only in exceptional circumstances will we consider not issuing a fine. Please note: an appointment overrunning or waiting in for parcels to be delivered are not acceptable reasons to collect your child late. If you have an appointment or specific plans, it is *your* responsibility to ensure you organise for your child to be collected.

As a reminder as per our late collection policy: if your child remains uncollected at the end of the school day and we are unable to make contact with yourselves or an emergency contact that you have given to us, then we will inform Children and Family Services.
