Dear Parents/Carers, Governors and Friends,

This week started with another four members of staff isolating and further children testing positive, affecting Woodlands in particular. To manage pupil staff ratios, we closed Nursery and Oak Class in agreement with the Local Authority. Subsequent further positive cases showed that this was the best decision. As staff end their isolation periods, we can open Oak Class again on Monday and it looks like Nursery children can return on Wednesday (if not sooner – tbc); we will keep a close eye on staff expected return dates next week.

Year 5 and 6 classes managed staff absences too through splitting classes between them. Thanks to all staff and children for managing all this so well and having additional numbers joining them.

Well done to all pupils who despite class closures or having to isolate have been able to participate in live learning sessions or completing the work that was set by their teachers at home. This could not be done without their parents/carers support either – thank you.

Breakfast Club costs changes – Good news for families with more than one child

From Monday 17th January, the cost of Breakfast Club will be changing if you have more than child attending. The prices will be as follows:

- 1 child attending – £3 per day as normal.
- 2 children attending – 1st child £3 per day, 2nd child £2 per day.
- 3 or more children attending – 1st child £3 per day, 2nd child £2 per day, 3rd child (and any more siblings) £1 per day.

Payment for Breakfast Club will still continue to work the same way, with payments made in advance on ParentPay.com. Children can only attend Breakfast Club when you have topped up their account in advance so that enough credit exists to cover the cost of the required sessions.

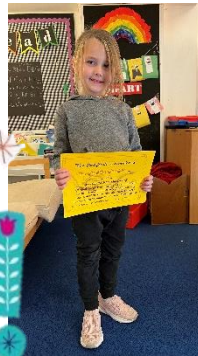

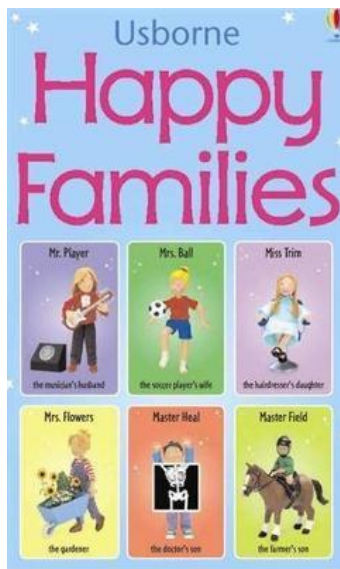
