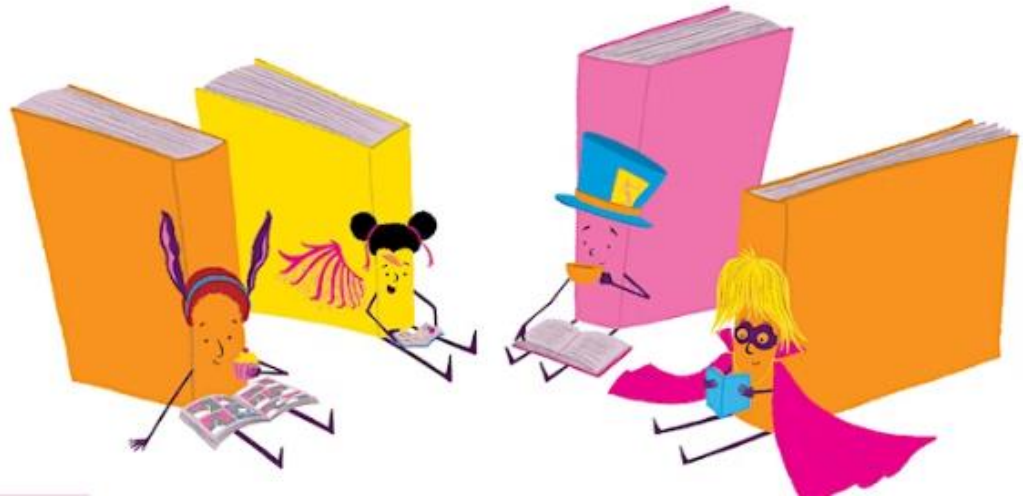
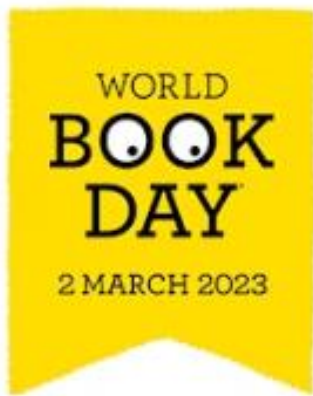

The semi-final for our school took place at PoW this week. 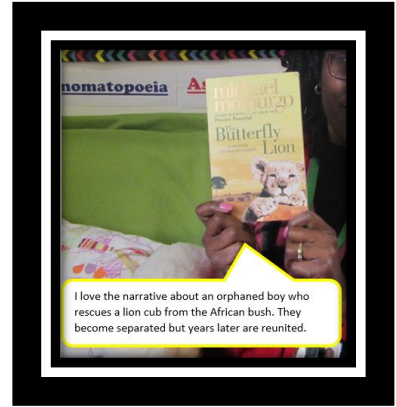


Masked Reader

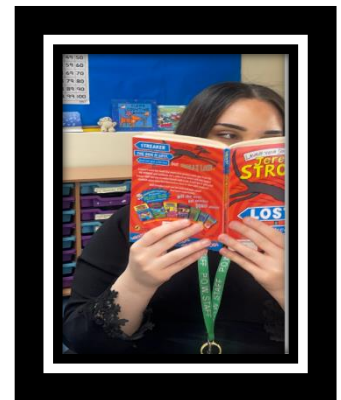


Who are these mystery readers? Our children ran around the playground to find all the photos and then work out the adults behind the covers of their favourite books.

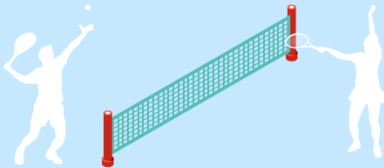

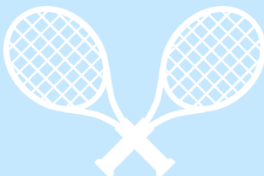
