e-Safety and Gaming

Our school debating team will be making the case against the motion 'Gaming is beneficial for children' in next week's ETSP competition. It was therefore interesting for the group to hear children's responses in Monday's e-Safety assembly that demonstrated overwhelming access to games and apps with age ratings from 13 to 18. They researched the impact of gaming including: copying violent behaviour seen on screens, strained interactions with family, tiredness, poor academic performance and its effect on mental and physical health. Add to that concerns about inappropriate Whatsapp messaging between Year 5 and 6 pupils this week. Air Quality around our School

We are participating in two air quality monitoring schemes. One with the Asthma + Lung UK and the other is by AECOM on behalf of Epping Forest District Council (in consultation with City of London Corporation). This is of course a learning opportunity for our Sustainability Leaders who join in when the diffusion tubes (air quality monitors) are installed and replaced as well as trying to understand what the data tells us about the air quality on our site. With many in our school community affected by asthma and breathing issues due to seasonal pollen allergies, it is important to anticipate the air quality and this site may be beneficial for parents/carers: Air pollution forecasts for Greater London. 
