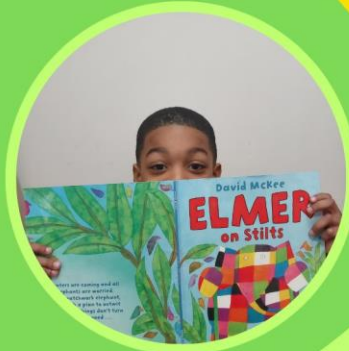

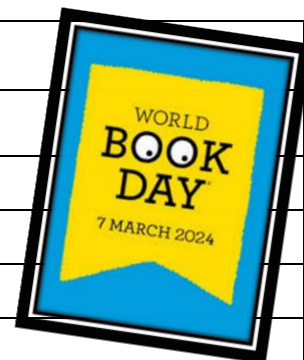

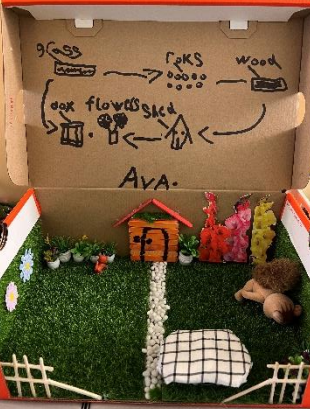
Netball tournament match report – Tuesday 27th February

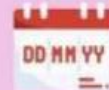
