

We had a few new players in both teams and everyone played fantastically. Well done POW! A big thank you to Mr Bless and Mrs Frith for coming out to support us.














### **Nursery went on a Bear Hunt**

The children were posed with a series of questions about what happens to our rubbish?








We learned about the different types of bins available and how we can reduce, re-use and re-cycle our waste.
